Special Leave


An employee who suffers an injury or illness arising out of and in the course of employment, shall not be required to use sick leave, annual leave, or compensatory leave if the employee meets one of the following criteria:

- a) Is quarantined at the direction of the employer due to confirmed or suspected COVID-19 exposure
- b) Receives a COVID-19 diagnosis from a physician.
- c) Receives a presumptive positive COVID-19 test.
- d) Receives a laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis.

Duration of Rule

This Rule is effective prospectively from August 19, 2020. The provisions of this Rule shall expire 120 days (December 17, 2020) after adoption by the board.
