

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING

The Livingston Parish Fire Protection District No. 4 Civil Service Board will hold a public hearing to consider the adoption of amendments to **Rule XII Leaves of Absence**, **section K Special Leave** of the civil service board rules. Unless cause is shown at this time why this amendment should not be adopted, the board will proceed to approve the adoption of the amendments in their proposed or revised form.

This public hearing will be held on November 24, 2020, at 1:00 p.m. at the Administrative Headquarters located at 9760 Florida Blvd Walker, LA 70785.

Special Leave

An employee who suffers an injury or illness arising out of and in the course of employment, shall not be required to use sick leave, annual leave, or compensatory leave if the employee meets one of the following criteria:

- a) Is quarantined at the direction of the employer due to confirmed or suspected COVID-19 exposure
- b) Receives a COVID-19 diagnosis from a physician.
- c) Receives a presumptive positive COVID-19 test.
- d) Receives a laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis.

Duration of Rule

This Rule is effective prospectively from December 17, 2020. The provisions of this Rule shall expire 120 days (*April 16, 2021*) after adoption by the board.
