Mr. Trey Sanders with Hannis T. Bourgeois, LLP reviewed the March 2026 Financial Report along with the Board Members. The Financial Report includes Balance Sheet for assets as well as liabilities and fund balance, Statement of Income, Budget to Actual, and General Fixed Assets.

Mr. Jay LeBlanc with Quality Engineering & Surveying, LLC presented the Engineer's Report:

- Station 11 contractors are finishing up countertop, paint, and floors with possible walk through scheduled mid-May. Quality Engineering is still working with the property owner of the north side to come to an agreement on the road. A discussion was held on a ribbon cutting in June.
- Station 7 is mostly cleared and finishing up the drainage system. The latest requirements for the property expansion have been provided by Quality Engineering.
- The Capital Programming Services is requesting extension of their contract from 2023. Chairman Dugas request this item be placed on the May Agenda.

There being no old or new business to discuss, the Board moved on to Chief's and Commissioner's reports

- Deputy Chief Jackson presented the response statistics for LPFPD4's total of 595 calls in March. Also presented the 2026 first quarter training report. He also announced the Louisiana High School Firefighter Training Program graduation is May 6, 2026.
- Fire Prevention Officer Matthew Gallman gave the 2026 first quarter fire prevention report.
